



TO: City and County Owners of the National Highway System (NHS) – Pavement and Bridges

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in partnership with the California Transportation Commission (Commission) will be hosting a kick-off webinar and a series of virtual workshops to engage transportation stakeholders in the development of the 2022 Transportation Asset Management Plan (TAMP) for California. The 2022 TAMP is the update to the initial plan approved by the Commission and certified by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) in March 2018. The TAMP is a coordinated plan by Caltrans and partner agencies to maintain and improve California's transportation infrastructure including the entire National Highway System (NHS) pavement and bridge assets owned by both Caltrans and many local transportation agencies. The kick-off webinar will focus on the connection between asset management, performance management, and the transportation planning and programming processes. After our initial kick-off, a series of workshops will follow for approximately 6 months that will focus on key elements of the plan including the NHS inventory and condition, life cycle planning, transportation risks, financial plans and investment strategies leading to the revisiting of performance targets for pavement and bridges on the NHS.

- Kick-off for the 2022 TAMP and Timeline
- Expert Panel discussion featuring both national and regional FHWA experts who will relate asset management, performance management, and the transportation planning and programming processes. A Question & Answer Session will follow.
