

NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR ADVANCE MITIGATION: CONNECTIVITY ADVANCE MITIGATION (CAM)

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) released the Wildlife Connectivity Advance Mitigation Guidelines in September 2024 to implement Senate Bill 790. These guidelines allow wildlife connectivity projects to earn mitigation credits, which can offset environmental impacts from development. A pilot phase invites stakeholder collaboration, and since this is a new approach, some crediting details are still being developed. CDFW will work closely with project sponsors during this initial phase.
